

## **Start-Up Costs**

You will incur some one-time costs just to get your business started. Listed below are some of the costs you might incur. You will need to research what your specific costs will be. In this example, the home facility is licensed for eight children on the 1<sup>st</sup> shift – five preschool and three after school. There is space for you to estimate your start-up costs.

Plumbing (new bathroom, diaper changing station)

Electrical work (wiring for computers, lights)

Tree removal/other landscaping for playground

Upgrade to septic system
